Dear Mr. Bayless:

Reference is made to your application dated November 19, 1997 for a non-standard gas well location for your proposed Tiger Well No. 3 to be drilled 1377 feet from the South line and 565 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 34, Township 30 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, to test the Pictured Cliffs formation, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SE/4 of said Section 34 shall be dedicated to the well to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division").

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(2), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
