

Manzano Oil Corporation hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 104 for the drilling of Manzano's Esperanza #1 as a Morrow well located 660' FSL and 990' FEL, Section 4, T-22-S, R-27-E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

Manzano Oil Corporation is seeking approval for an unorthodox location in the South Carlsbad area Eddy County, New Mexico, based on geologic reasons. The proposed unorthodox location for the Esperanza #1 (S/2 proration unit / 660' FSL & 990' FEL, Section 4, 22S-27E) is targeting the Upper Strawn C carbonate and the Morrow B sand as primary objectives with the Delaware sands and Wolfcamp carbonate as secondary objectives. The Upper Strawn C interval consists of isolated carbonate mounds oriented in a SW-NE direction (see Upper Strawn C porosity map). In the southwest quarter of Section 4 (W/2 of proposed S/2 proration unit), Belco Petroleum Corporation drilled and completed the Union Mead Com. #2 in January 1973. This well encountered 47 feet of gross Strawn C limestone with no porosity >4%. Belco attempted a completion on the Strawn C recovering only 72 MCFGPD. While the "Upper Strawn C Carbonate Net Feet of Porosity Map" shows possible porosity development at a regular location, a well at the proposed unorthodox location should penetrate a thicker better developed portion of the Strawn C mound (provided that a mound even exists) than a well drilled at a standard gas well location, thereby increasing the likelihood of encountering porosity significant enough to make a commercial producer within the Strawn C.

As with the Strawn C, the Morrow B sand was perforated and tested tight in the Belco Union Mead Com. #2 resulting in an uncommercial completion (the Belco Union Mead Com. #2 was ultimately plugged back to the Wolfcamp where a successful completion was made). The greatest risk to drilling a Morrow B well in the SE/4 of Section 4 is whether or not sands of adequate porosity and permeability will be encountered. Given that the sands in the Belco Union Mead (E/2SW/4) were tight and unproductive, Manzano believes that drilling a well only one location to the east (a standard gas well location) would be extremely risky at best. If a Morrow B sand channel does cross the SE/4 of Section 4, it would be best developed in the E/2SE/4. As with the Upper Strawn C, a well drilled at the proposed unorthodox location has an increased likelihood of making a commercial producer in the Morrow B than a well at a regular gas well location.

By separate letters (copies attached) Manzano has sent notification letters via certified return receipt mail to the affected parties. Also attached is a copy of a letter from Matador Petroleum Corporation to Manzano agreeing to not protest our location. Matador got their interest from Unocal by assignment filed January 22, 1998.

Reference is made to your letter dated January 14, 1998 proposing to drill the Esperanza #2 well located in the West Half of Section 3. Pursuant to our phone conversation, it is our understanding that this proposal has been delayed until such time as you have completed your well in Section 4, T-22-S, R-27-E.

Although the well you plan to drill in Section 4 is an unorthodox location, Matador has agreed not to protest your proposed location. We feel that the information from the well in Section 4 will be a valuable tool for evaluating the future development in Section 3 for both of our companies. As a matter of reference, we are enclosing our well requirements letter for your use in providing Matador with the well data from the well drilled in Section 4.

Additionally, although we do not presently have all of Spirit's files in our possession, we understand that the S/2 Section 4 was originally committed to a farmout to Belco. However, the well drilled pursuant to that Agreement, the Union Mead Com #2 well, has since been plugged and abandoned. We are researching this matter to determine whether or not the farmout acreage should be reassigned to Matador (Spirit). If you have any information regarding this matter, we would appreciate you sharing it with us.

As we discussed, with regard to the well to be proposed in Section 3, our records indicate that the November 4, 1968 Joint Operating Agreement remains in effect and the well should therefore be proposed under the existing contract. If you need a copy of the Agreement, please feel free to give me a call. We appreciate your assistance in this matter and look forward to the opportunity to work together in this project.

Gentlemen:

Per earlier conversation with Robin Benko of your offices, Manzano Oil corporation ("Manzano") is proposing to drill a Morrow test well at a legal location 660'FSL & 990'FEL of Section 4 above. Other possible commercial pays in this area include the Strawn, Atoka, Wolfcamp and Delaware formations.

You have leasehold interests in this area arising out of your interest in the Union Mead Com No. 2 well (located in the SW/4 of this section and P&A'd in 1990 by Quinoco). Although the majority of the leasehold in the S/2 of Section 4 was lost by the plugging of this and subsequent well(s) by UNOCAL, mineral interests covering in the aggregate an undivided 25.00% interest in the SE/4 of this section continue to be held by production from UNOCAL's Tracy No. 1 well, located in the NW/4 of Section 10 on lands still owned by UNOCAL et al.

We ask that you join with us in the drilling of this well which we anticipate commencing on or before April 30th and we have enclosed an AFE and Operating Agreement for your review. Your interests are as set forth on the Exhibit "A" to the Operating Agreement. Should you not wish to participate, we offer to take an Assignment of your leasehold interest(s) for \$200.00 per net acre or a (2 year) Term Assignment for \$100.00 per net acre. Again, your net acres are as shown on Exhibit "A". We cannot offer to farm in this leasehold as it already has royalty and overriding royalty burdens totaling 25.00%, and is further encumbered by a 25.00% "back-in" after payout reserved by UNOCAL et al in assignments to your predecessors in title (Belco).

As noted above in Paragraph 1, our location for this well is unorthodox. No matter which option you choose to elect, we ask that you waive any objection to this location in order to assure us of administrative approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in a hearing set for the third week in February in Santa Fe. This location has been chosen to maximize our potential for the multiple possible pays on this acreage. We control (approximately 81.25%) the balance of the acreage in the proration unit to the east (Section 3) for

Manzano Oil Corporation ("Manzano") is proposing to drill a Morrow test well at a legal location 1650'FSL & 990'FWL of Section 3 above. We have also staked, and are planning on drilling first, a Morrow test to the West, in Section 4, at a location 660'FSL & 990'FEL.

You have leasehold interests in the W/2 of this section covering in the aggregate an undivided 25.00% interest in the SW/4 and the S/2NW/4 of Section 3, held by production from UNOCAL's Tracy No. 1 well, located in the NW/4 of Section 10. 
EXECUTE AND RETURN






