The ESD Vessel did not shut causing the pop off valve to overflow. A vac-truck was called and all standing fluids were vacuumed up and disposed of.

The area affected was across the location into the pasture. The produced water is approx 1500ppm in Chlorides. The affected areas were washed with 40bbls. of fresh water and microblaze was put on to assist in the clean-up. This area will be monitored for further growth.
