Burlington Resources proposes to drill the above reference well location as a Basin Fruitland Coal well and is applying for administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the FC formation.

The subject well was staked 615' FNL & 1400' FWL, Sec. 26, T27N, R10W a non-standard location as per Order R-8768-F for the Fruitland Coal. As shown on the topo map, the NW/4 of Section 12 is primarily in severe topographic terrain. Rugged terrain and large washes, along with scattered archaeological sites encompass a majority of the area within the legal spacing window for the Fruitland Coal formation. In order to find a suitable site for this well requires it to be staked as a non-standard location.

To comply with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division rules, we are submitting the following for your approval of this non-standard:

- > Approved application for Permit to Drill and C102 at referenced location
- > Offset operator plat
- > 9 section plat
- > Topography plat of Section 26

Production from the Basin Fruitland Coal is included in the 320.0 acre gas spacing unit, the north half dedication of Section 26, T27N, R10W.





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
