Reference is made to your application submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on September 22, 1998 for an exception to the well location requirements provided within the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-10987. The E/2 of Section 31, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico is to be dedicated to the proposed well in order to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.



Further, the aforementioned well and spacing unit will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest, New Mexico.
