Dear Ms. Serrano:

Reference is made to your application dated January 18, 1999 for a non-standard gas well location within the Cabresto Canyon-Ojo Alamo Pool for Mallon Oil Company's proposed Jicarilla 457-9 Well No. 2 to be drilled 695 feet from the North line and 731 feet from the West line (Lot 4/Unit D) of Section 9, Township 30 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Lots 3 and 4 and the S/2 NW/4 (NW/4 equivalent) of Section 9 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 152.12-acre gas spacing and proration unit.
