

BTA Oil Producers hereby seeks administrative approval to drill at the above referenced location in the Grama Ridge, Morrow Gas Pool with the south half of Section 16 dedicated to this well. This location in the Morrow formation, is unorthodox because it is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provide for wells on 320 acre spacing units to be located no closer than 660 feet to the nearest side boundary nor closer than 1650 feet to the nearest end boundary.

Attached hereto is Exhibit "A", a Morrow Structure Map, and Exhibit "B" a Morrow Net Sand Isopach Map. The proposed unorthodox well location is necessary to enable BTA to locate this well in the thickest portion of the Morrow channel while, while maintaining an optimum structural position, under the South half of Section 16.

We are enclosing an area of the Lea County map showing the offsetting leases operated by Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. BTA would be encroaching on Section 17 to the west. BTA has notified Santa Fe by certified mail and requested their signing of a waiver. We are enclosing the "green card" PS Form 3811 signed by Santa Fe on 04/08/99. We are also enclosing the signed certificate of notification for the Commissioner of Public Lands.







Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the request by BTA Oil Producers (BTA) for administrative approval of the above referenced unorthodox well location. As you know Santa Fe Snyder Corporation (Santa Fe) filed an objection to the proposed location and this matter has been set for hearing before the NMOCD.

In an effort to reach a mutually acceptable compromise in this matter, Santa Fe hereby agrees to waive its objection to the above referenced unorthodox well location in exchange for a guarantee by BTA that it will (i) grant Santa Fe waivers of mirror unorthodox locations for the drilling of Morrow tests in Sections 17, 20 and 21, T-22-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and (ii) provide Santa Fe with all logs and tests results acquired in connection with drilling the above referenced well as outlined on the attached Exhibit "A". 






A. TOTAL DEPTH


