Dear Ms. Haynie:

We are in receipt of your letter of July 23, 2008 notifying this office of your intent to surface commingle the oil and gas production from the Blinebry, Drinkard, and Penrose Skelly Grayburg formations for the following wells at the State "DC" Battery.

- State DC #3, API # 30-025-34401, (F) Sec. 19-21S-37E, Lease No. B-1040-6.
- State DC # 4, API # 30-025-34510 (Lot 2) Sec. 19-21S-37E, Lease No. B-1040-6.
- Harry Leonard J #5, API # 30-025-38789 (A) Sec. 24-21S-36E, Lease No. B-1732-1

It is our understanding that Chevron will run a flowline from the Harry Leonard J# 5 in Section 24 to the State "DC" Battery (Section 19) connecting to a dedicated 3-phase separator with meters for oil and gas.

Since it appears that all the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's rules and regulations have been complied with, and there will be no loss of revenue to the State of New Mexico, as a result of your proposed operation, your request is hereby approved. Our approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
