Burlington Resources is applying for administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the Basin Fruitland Coal pool. This application for the referenced location is primarily due to the LaPlata River that runs through the middle of the window, the presence of wetlands, and to avoid the irrigated hayfields. Archaeology is also present within the standard windows.

Production from the Fruitland Coal pool is to be included in a 320 acre gas spacing unit for the north half (N/2) in Section 34.

Dear Ms. Heath:

Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company (hereafter referred to as Burlington) appreciates Hallwood Petroleum, Inc. (hereafter referred to as Hallwood) cooperation in allowing Burlington access across Hallwood's Tafoya L 2-35 well location to access Burlington's Montoya A 34 #100 new drill.

As we have discussed the Montoya A 34 #100 is proposed to be drilled as a non-standard Fruitland Coal well. This well is nonstandard due to the La Plata River and associated topography precluding a standard location.

Burlington appreciates Hallwood's cooperation concerning this project and understands Hallwood's concerns in regards to the proposed non-standard location. In our telephone conversation on Thursday, June 17, 1999 Hallwood agreed to waive any objection to the non-standard location if Burlington agreed to share well information which would eliminate both parties having to go to a non-standard location hearing before the OCD in Santa Fe. Burlington agrees to the following in regards to the drilling of Burlington's Montoya A 34 #100 well.

1. Burlington will provide the following well information to Hallwood, within ten (10) days of Burlington's receipt of such information.
 - a. Open Hole Logs
 - b. Completion Report
 - c. Shut-in pressure data
2. Since Burlington will access its well location across Hallwood's Tafoya L 2-35 well location.



- a. Burlington agrees to pay 50% of the road maintenance costs from the point where the access road to the Tafoya L 2-35 and Montoya A 34-#100 leaves San Juan County Road #1305 to the Tafoya L 2-35. Burlington shall pay 100% of the road maintenance from the Tafoya L 2-35 well pad to the Montoya A 34 #100 well pad.
- b. Burlington will upgrade and gravel the Tafoya L 2-35 access road from the point where the well access road leaves San Juan County Road #1305.

If Hallwood is in agreement to the above stated terms as they relate to the drilling of Burlington's Montoya A 34 #100 well, please evidence your agreement by executing below and returning the executed Letter of Understanding to the undersigned.

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
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
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
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
