Dear Mr. Marshall:

Reference is made to your request dated March 7, 2000 to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted March 6, 2000. The results of the tests have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

<i>Well and Location</i>	<i>Maximum Injection Pressure</i>
Wallen Bass Federal Well No. 2	1,450 PSIG
Located in Section 21, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico.	

The Division Director may rescind these injection pressure increases if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
