Reference is made to your request dated June 15, 2000 to increase the surface injection pressure on three wells in the above referenced waterflood project. This request is based on step rate test conducted on June 13, 2000. The results of the test have been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on these wells is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following wells:
