Dear Sir:

Under the provision of Commission Order No. R-520, Rules 3 and 5 (b) delegating the Secretary of the Commission authority to grant exceptions to the requirements of Rule No. 5 (a) without notice and hearing for non-standard gas proration unit, Two States Oil Company hereby applies for an exception to the above-mentioned rule for Mary L. McQuatters No. 1, Eumont Field.

Mary L. McQuatters No. 1 is located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 36 East. This well was completed February 9, 1937, as an oil well in the Eunice Field and tested 333 barrels of oil in 12 hours.

Because of declining production, notice of intention to recom-  
plete the well was filed on November 17, 1952, and approval was  
granted on November 18, 1952.

It was recompleted on February 17, 1953, and potentialled 1,750  
MCFPD on open flow from the Queens-7 Rivers formation. The casing  
perforations were from 3218 feet to 3628 feet and the top gas pay  
is at 3218 feet.

Regarding the exception to Rule No. 5 (a) we wish to state the  
following:

- (A) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit of 120 acres consists of the S/2 NE/4 and NW/4 of SE/4 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 36 East.



- (B) That the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (C) That the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be expected to be productive of gas.
- (D) That the length or width of the proposed non-standard gas proration unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
- (E) That the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies within the horizontal limits of the Eumont Gas Pool.
- (F) That by copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the section in which the non-standard gas proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit and all operators owning interest within 1500 feet of the well have been notified by registered mail of this application as shown below.

A plat showing the acreage to be dedicated, well location and offset ownership is attached.




