Gentlemen:

In accordance with order R-520 the undersigned hereby requests a non-standard unit consisting of 160 acres in Lea County, New Mexico as follows:

1. The complete legal description of acreage included is:
SE 1/4 Section 24, T. 22S, R. 35E
containing 160 acres.
2. Schermerhorn Oil Corporation, Amerada State #1 completed gas well is located 1,980' from South and 660' from East lines of Section 24.
3. Plat is attached showing acreage to be included in the unit well location and all offset lease ownership.
4. It is the intention of the operator to produce the gas well from the Yates formation as a non-standard gas unit comprising 160 acres in the Jalmat gas pool.
5. Copies of this request for a non-standard proration gas unit have been mailed to all the offset operators as listed below.
