
In accordance with order R-520 the undersigned hereby requests a non-standard unit consisting of 160 acres in Lea County, New Mexico as follows:

1. The complete legal description of acreage included is:  
NE/4 Section 12, T-22-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico,  
containing 160 acres.
2. The Carper Drilling Company, Inc., Carper-Continental State 1-A  
completed gas well is located 660' from the North line and 660' from  
the East line of Section 12.
3. Plat is attached showing acreage to be included in the unit well location  
and all offset lease ownership.
4. It is the intention of the operator to produce the gas well from the Yates  
formation as a non-standard gas unit comprising 160 acres in the Jalmat  
gas pool.

to all the offset operators as listed below.


This request for a 160 acre gas unit is in accordance with the Commissions rules



Gas Well Plat



Dear Sir:

On March 3, 1955 Carper Drilling Company, Inc. as the owner of Oil and Gas Lease No. E-268 covering the W/2 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M. in Lea County, New Mexico, and Continental Oil Company as the owner of Oil and Gas Lease No. B-1535 covering the E/2 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M. in Lea County, New Mexico, entered into a Communitization Agreement communitizing the two above described 80 acre tracts for the purpose of developing dry gas and liquid hydrocarbons therefrom producible from the Yates, Seven Rivers and Queen Sand Formations. This Communitization Agreement was approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands on March 16, 1955.

Thereafter Carper Drilling Company, Inc. drilled a well in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M. in Lea County, New Mexico, and obtained a gas well making approximately 10,500,000 cubic feet of gas per day.

It is our understanding that so long as this gas well is producing Oil and Gas Lease No. E-268 and Oil and Gas Lease No. B-1535 covering the lands in the above mentioned Communitization Agreement and other lands in each respective lease will be perpetuated by production from this gas well located in the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 12.

Will you please advise us by letter whether we are correct in our

Commissioner of Public Lands


