Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Lockhart "B-31" Well No. 2, located 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line in SE/4 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.

Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520 for a non-standard gas proration unit for its Lockhart B-31 No. 2 well located 660' FSL and 1980' FWL of Section 31, T-21S., R-36E., Lea County, New Mexico in the Jalmat gas pool. This well was recently reclassified as a gas well.

The unit is proposed to consist of the SE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 31, T-21S., R-36E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

1. Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections (and/or lots).
2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission issue an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's Lockhart B-31 No. 2 well as described above.
