Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

- a. That the applicant has recompleted its William Weir Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the west line and 660 feet from the south line of Section 23, R-36E, T-19S, in the Eumont Gas Pool at a plugback total depth of 3925 feet.
- b. That the applicant proposes to assign to this well a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of that portion of the William Weir Lease being 160 acres which lies within said Section 23 and being the E/2 SE/4, SW/4 SE/4, and SE/4 SW/4 of said section. Queen
- c. That 160 acres of the said lease, being the W/2 NE/4 of Section 25 and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 26, R-36E, T-19S, has heretofore been assigned to The Texas Company's William Weir Well No. 1.
- d. That the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit is wholly within the horizontal limits of the Eumont Gas Pool as set out in Order R-520 and the completion interval of 3700 to 3925 feet lies wholly within the vertical limits of the Eumont Gas Pool as set out in the said order.
- e. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section that does not exceed 5280 feet in length or width and that it consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.

- f. That the proposed non-standard proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas. That the Commission has previously approved proration units for offset wells as follows:

Gulf	Bell 1	H	23-19-36	160 acres
Sun	Barr 2	L	24-19-37	160 acres
The Texas Co.	Wm Weir 1	E	25-19-36	160 acres
Amerada	Weir "B" 1	G	26-19-36	160 acres

- g. That by copy of this letter of application and by registered mail, all offset operators as defined in Paragraph 5 of Rule 5B of Order R-520 are notified. The Texas Company by copy of this letter is hereby requesting waivers from Gulf Oil Corporation and Southern Petroleum Exploration, Inc., who own interest in Section 23, and from Amerada Petroleum Corporation and Continental Oil Company who own interests outside Section 23 but within 1500 feet of the same well.

The Texas Company requests that a non-standard gas proration unit be approved for this well as soon as waivers are received from the above four companies.


