Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 23 South, Range 36 East
S/2 of Section 27

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your W. H. (C+Z) Combest Well No. 1, located 1650 feet from the south line and 990 feet from the east line and in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 27, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as you enclosed waivers from the offset operator agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-5 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320 acres.
