Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of
a non-standard gas proration unit comprising Lots 13 and 14, and the SW/4
Section 2, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof
states the following facts:

- (1) By Administrative Order NSP-53 dated January 5, 1955, Gulf Oil Corporation was authorized to operate its J. F. Janda "D" Lease comprising Lots 13 and 14, and the N/2 SW/4 of Section 2, T-21-S, R-36-E, as a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit with such unit to be ascribed to Gulf's J. F. Janda "D" #1 which is located 1980' from the South line and 660' from the West line of said section.
- (2) Cities Service Oil Company is the owner and operator of the 80-acre lease comprising the S/2 SW/4 of Section 2, T-21-S, R-36-E, which is designated as Cities Service Oil Company - State "G" Lease.
- (3) Subject to the authorization of the Oil Conservation Commission for the operation of Gulf's J. F. Janda "D" Lease (160 acres) and Cities Service Oil Company's State "G" Lease (80 acres) as a non-standard 240-acre gas proration unit and the ascribing of the 240-acre unit to Gulf's J. F. Janda "D" #1, Gulf and Cities Service have agreed to enter into gas pooling and operating agreements covering such acreage for the production of their respective shares of gas-well gas from the Eumont Formation.

Communication

- (4) Gulf Oil Corporation's J. F. Janda "D" #1 is the only Eumont gas well on the proposed 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit and this well is already connected to a gas transportation facility.
- (5) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
- (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
 - (e) By copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation and Cities Service Oil Company to form this proposed unit. (See attached affidavit)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.



Scale 1" = 2,000'


