Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM
NW/4 NW/4 of Section 16

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State "G" Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the north and west lines and in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 16, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as we received waivers from the offset operators agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-5 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres. The allowable will become effective on the date of connection.
