Gentlemen:

General Crude Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520 for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for its State "G" Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 16, T 20 S, R 37 E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Eumont gas pool.

The unit consists of 40 acres comprised of the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 16, T 20 S, R 37 E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

1. Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished by registered mail to all offset operators, all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, and all operators in the section which is Federal Land.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge or belief the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset ownership.

This well is a dual completion in the Monument Field, oil zone, and the Eumont Field, gas zone. Authority for the dual completion is New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. DC-211.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission issue an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for General Crude Oil Company's State "G" No. 1 Well as described above.

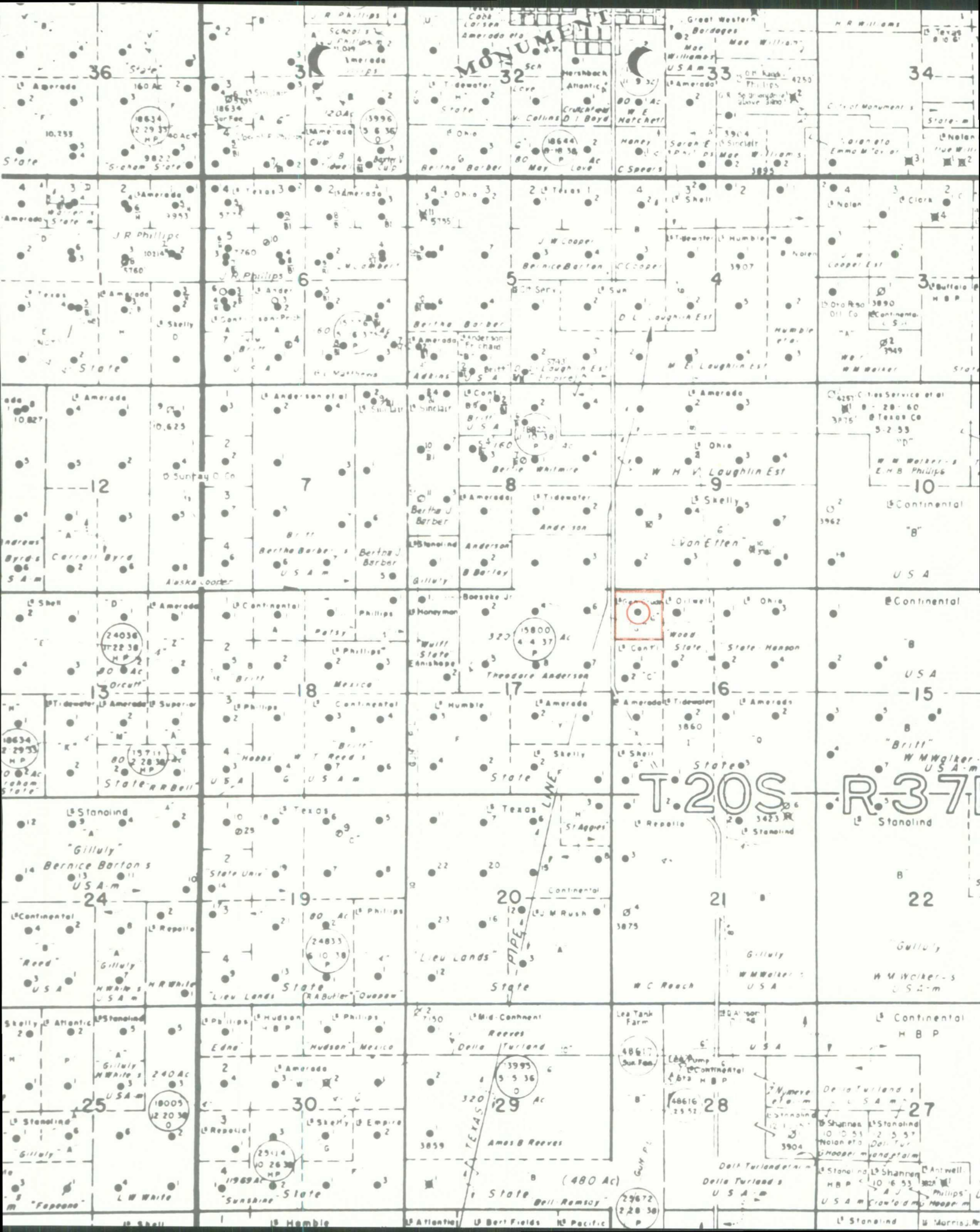

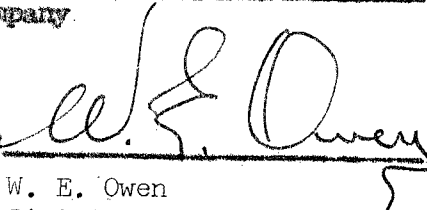

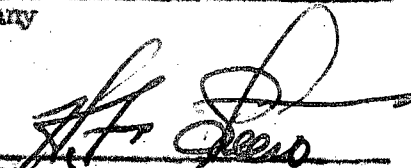
