Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Van Zandt Well No. 4, located 1650 feet from the north and east lines and in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 25, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b), Section 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.
