Gentlemen:

Administrative Order NSP-221 dated January 7, 1936
is superseded by this order.

Reference is made to your application for approval
of a 304.83-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont
Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 21 South, Range 36 East
Lots 1 through 8 inclusive in Section 6

or

Township 21 South, Range 36 East
Lots 1 through 3 and Lots 6 through 8
of Section 6

or the immediate approval of the alternate 236.45 acre unit
on same tract.

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed
to your H. T. Orcutt "C" (State) Well No. 6, located 660 feet
from the North line and 1850 feet from the East line and in
Lot 3 of Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPN,
Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b), Section 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 305 acres after successfully communitizing said acreage. Until communitization is effected with Atlantic Refining Company and the New Mexico State Land Office, you are hereby authorized to operate your own acreage or Lots 1 through 3 and Lots 6 through 8 of Section 6 as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 236 acres.
