Until communitization is effected with Atlantic Refining Company and the New Mexico State Land Office, you are bereby authorized to operate your own acreage or Lots 1 through 3 and Lots 6 through 8 of Section 6 as a non-standard gas provation unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 236 acres.
