Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM
SW/4, W/2 SE/4 and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 16

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your J. R. Holt "A" Well No. 2, located 660 feet from the south line and 1960 feet from the west line and in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 16, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b), Section 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R. 520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 280 acres.
