Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 319.88-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM
W/2 of Section 2

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State "AS" Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the North and West lines and in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as you enclosed waivers from the offset operators agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-5 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320 acres. The allowable shall be effective the first day of the month following receipt of an affidavit from you indicating the consummation of the communitization agreement of the working interests. This notification shall be sent to our Hobbs office with a copy to the Santa Fe office.
