Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Meyer "A-17" Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the South and West lines and in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres.
