Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool contained in Order No. R-520 in order to form a non-standard gas proration unit for its A. E. Meyer B-4 No. 7 well located 1980 feet from South and East lines of Section 4, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Eumont Gas Pool and for cancellation of Order No. NSP-122.

The unit is proposed to consist of 360 acres, being Lots 14, 15 and 16; the Southeast Quarter and the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 4, T21S, R36E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

- Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections (and/or lots).
- 2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
- The length or width of said unit does not exceed 4. 5,280 feet.
- Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by said Rule 5 (b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset ownership.

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In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission issue an order approving the nonstandard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's A. E. Meyer B-4 No. 7 well as described above.

Continental further requests that the 160-acre unit assigned to its A. E. Meyer B-4 No. 6 under the provisions of Order No. NSP-122 be cancelled upon approval of this proposed proration unit inasmuch as that acreage is included in the proposed unit. Well No. 6, to which the 160-acre unit is assigned, will be shut-in.


