Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Sumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 28 South, Range 37 East
N2/4 & E/2 N2/4 of Section 28.

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Meyer B-28 "A" Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the north and east lines and in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 28, Township 28 South, Range 37 East, NMPN, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Sumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order S-320, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres upon receipt of an affidavit of communitization.
