Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Sumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State "N" Well No. 5, located 660 feet from the south and west lines and in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Sumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order A-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
