It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Farnsworth Well No. 2-C located 1630 feet from the North and East lines and in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 4, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 8 of the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 280 acres.
