Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5(b) of Order No. R-520 of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit of 160.00 acres, more or less, comprising the W/2 E/2 of Section 4, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. That El Paso Natural Gas Company holds the gas operating rights under the W/2 E/2 of Section 4, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M.

2. That El Paso Natural Gas Company completed the El Paso Natural Gas Company Wells Federal #2 Well on May 22, 1956. That said well is located 1980 feet from the North and East lines of Section 4, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M. That the well was drilled to a total depth of 3148 feet and was completed as a gas well in the Jalmat Gas Pool with an initial potential of 37,000 MCF absolute open flow.

3. That the proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of Order No. R-520 in that the proposed unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections within a single governmental section, that the length or width thereof does not exceed 5280 feet, and that the entire area of the proposed unit lies within the horizontal limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool and may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

4. That by a copy of this Letter of Application, all of the other operators owning an interest in the section in which the proposed Non-Standard Proration Unit is situated and all operators owning an interest within 1500 feet of the well have by registered mail been notified.

5. That a plat showing the acreage to be dedicated to the proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit, the location of the said well, and the offset ownership is attached hereto.




