Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 37 East  
SE/4 and S/2 NE/4 of Section 14

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your SEM-Permian Well No. 46, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line and in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPL, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order B-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres.
