Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 157-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Sumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 19 South, Range 37 East
Lots 1 & 2 & E/2 NW/4 of Section 30

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State "C-30" Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the North line and 1960 feet from the West line and in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 30, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Sumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 12 of the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 157 acres.
