Gentlemen: Re: Application for Blinebry Gas NSP Unit - Wantz, No. 8

We forward herewith application in triplicate for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry gas pool for our Wantz well No. 8 located in Unit O, Sec. 21-T21S-R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

A non-standard unit of 120 acres in size was approved for the well (formerly designated Wantz No. 4-A) by administrative order No. NSP-487. Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5C of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Gas Pool of Order No. R-1670 for the formation of a 40 acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the SW/4, SE/4 of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, for its Wantz No. 8 well located 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Blinebry Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5C in all respects as follows:

1. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of a single quarter-quarter section.
2. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental quarter section.
3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 2,640 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within the same quarter section or within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5C.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 8 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission enter an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's Wantz No. 8 well as described above.
