Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 4: E/2 NW/4 and SW/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Rinewalt Well No. 4, located 760 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 4.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Tubb Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.

This order shall be effective the date a notice of disconnection is filed for your Rinewalt Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 4.
