Re: Application of Gulf Oil Corporation For
Administrative Approval of a 280-Acre Non-
Standard Gas Proration Unit, Jalmat Gas Pool,
Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval of a 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, covering the SW/4, W/2 NW/4 and SE/4 NW/4 Section 4-22S-36E, Lea County, New Mexico. This non-standard unit is to be attributed to the J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 7 located 1980 feet from the south and west lines of this Section 4. The attached plat shows this non-standard unit outlined in red.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Applicant's J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 7 is dually completed in the South Eunice Oil and Jalmat Gas Pools. Administrative Order NSP-695 dated November 2, 1964 approved a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit for this well covering the SW/4 and W/2 NW/4 of Section 4.
- (2) Applicant's J. F. Janda (NCT-F) Well No. 3 located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 4 was dually completed in the Jalmat and South Eunice Oil Pools; however, the Oil Conservation Commission has advised that effective July 1, 1965, this well will be reclassified as a Jalmat Gas well. It is proposed to attribute this 40 acres to Well No. 7 to form the non-standard 280-acre gas proration unit.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter quarter sections or lots.
- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (5) The entire non-standard unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
- (6) The length or width of the proposed non-standard unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.

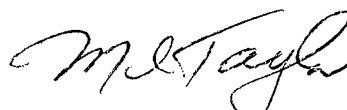


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- (7) Applicant owns all the leasehold interest in the section in which the proposed non-standard unit is located and within 1500 feet of the unit well.
