We respectfully submit this application for and request approval of a 40-acre non-standard oil proration unit in the Fowler Blinebry Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST
SE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) Of Section 22

This unit will be assigned to our South Mattix Unit Well No. 12, located 766 feet from the South line and 554 feet from the East line of Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

This non-standard proration unit was occasioned by the recent re-entry and completion of our South Mattix Unit Well No. 12 in the Blinebry formation.

In support of our request for exception approval without notice and hearing to Rule 2 of Order No. R-2424-A, the following is submitted:

1. This application is submitted in triplicate.
2. This non-standard oil proration unit consists of a single quarter-quarter section and lies within the horizontal limits of the Fowler Blinebry Oil Pool.
3. By certified mail copies of this letter are being furnished the offset operators notifying that application is being made for the non-standard proration unit.


