Gentlemen:

Forwarded herewith in triplicate is an application for an 80-acre non-standard unit for our Jack Federal 19 Well No. 4. We were informed by the Hobbs District office that well No. 2 located in the SE/4 NW/4 Section 19 has been reclassified as a Jalmat gas well effective July 1, 1969. Rather than establish a separate gas proration unit for that well, we propose to leave that well shut-in and allocate its 40-acre tract to No. 4 which is already connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system.

It is respectfully requested that this non-standard unit be approved and that its effective date coincide with the reclassification of well No. 2 which is July 1, 1969. Your further handling and approval of this application will be sincerely appreciated.

Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative
approval under the provisions of Rule 5(c) of the Special Rules and Regu-
lations for the Jalmat Gas Pool of Order No. R-1670 for the formation of
an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of E/2 NW/4 Section
19, T-24S, R-37E, for its Jack Federal 19 Well No. 4, located 990 feet from
the north line and 1587 feet from the west line of Section 19, T-24S, R-37E,
Lea County, New Mexico, in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the
proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5(c) in all respects
as follows:

1. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists
of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
2. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly
within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may
be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. A copy of this application has been sent to all offset
operators and all operators in the same section.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 4 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.

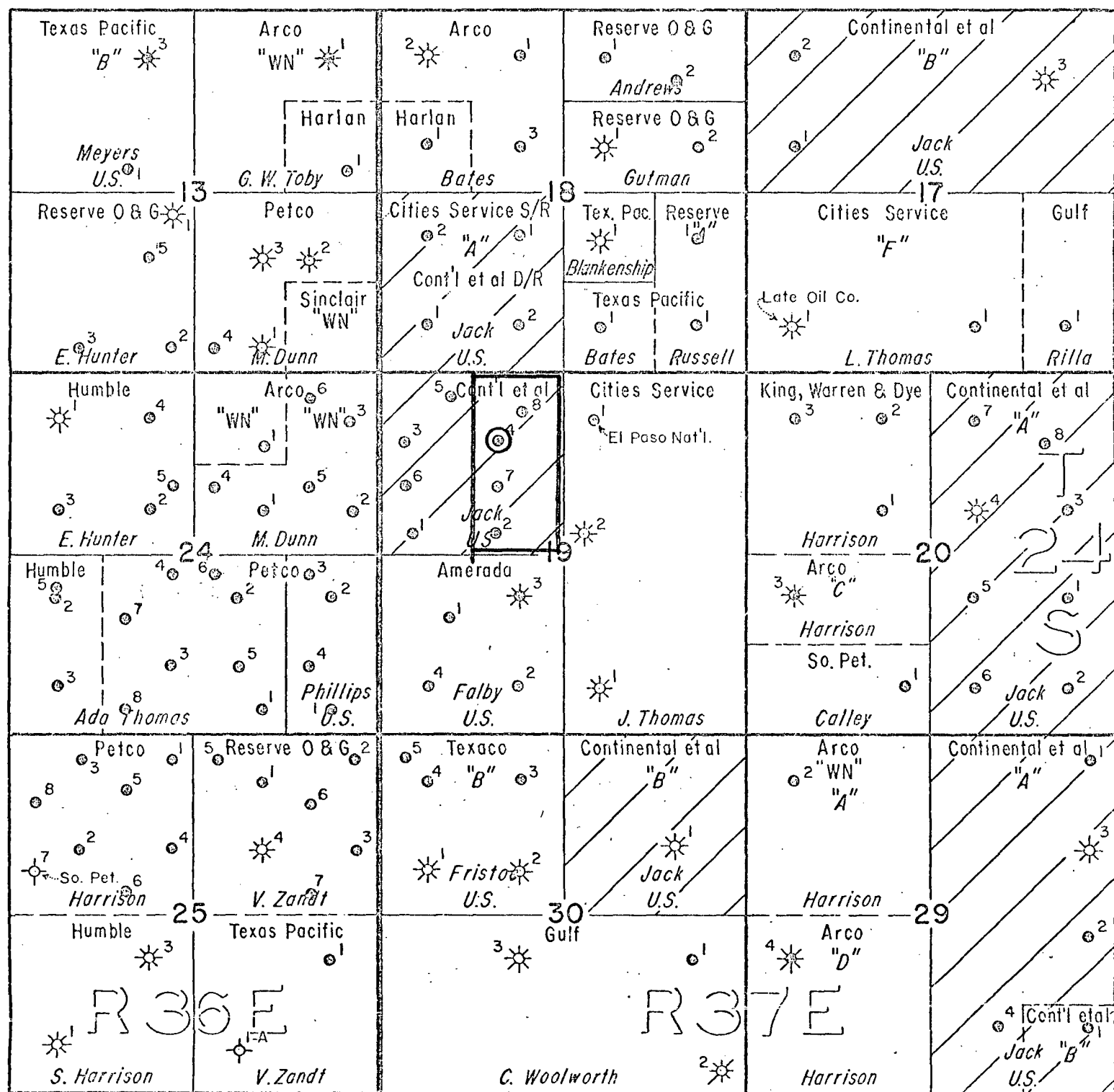
The granting of this application is in the interest of preventing waste and the protection of correlative rights.
