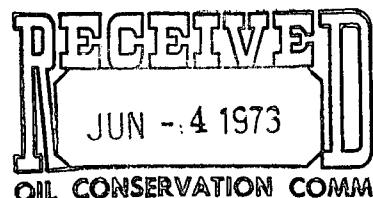

Gentlemen:

We have plugged back our No. 1 Gutman Well, situated 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 29, and have completed it as a Yates gas producer in the Jalmat Field. Our lease acreage consists of the above captioned acreage only, and we therefore request that you approve a non-standard gas proration unit for our well consisting of the N/2 SE/4 of Section 29.

We are enclosing three copies of a plat showing the location of the well and the proposed 80 acre proration unit which is colored in red. Also shown on the plat are the off-setting operators to our proposed 80 acre unit.

A copy of this letter and the enclosed plat has been sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to all off-setting operators, to-wit: Bettis, Boyle & Stovall, Texas Pacific Oil Company and Atlantic Richfield Company.
