


Dear Mr. Chacon:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) completed an inspection of the Majority Services Facility (oil service company) located in Hobbs, New Mexico on June 17, 2008. During the inspection, the NMOCD identified an Underground Injection Control (UIC) Class V Well in your mechanic shop.

Based on the above, the NMOCD has determined that your facility requires a discharge permit under the Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) 20.6.2 NMAC. The NMOCD hereby requires Majority Services to submit a discharge permit application with \$100 filing fee (check made out to the "Water Quality Management Fund") within 30 days of receipt of this letter. The NMOCD recommends that you contact an environmental consultant familiar with the NMOCD discharge permit process to assist you with the discharge permit application.
