It is understood that the subject well tested for 80 MCF gas and 1½ barrels condensate per day from Morrow sand perforations.




I have recently recompleted my Lone Star Federal #1 located in section 20-T8S-R36E in Roosevelt County, New Mexico

My completion report results showed the well was capable of producing only 100 MCF per day and 3 bbls. of oil.


Since the well is not capable of producing as a prorated unit for 320 acre spacing, I would like to request an allowable for an unorthodox 40 acre producing unit.
