

Tank overflowed due to power failure at site. All fluids were contained inside the firewalls at the battery site. Remediation efforts complete. Soil samples and tests were gathered at this site and discussed with NMOCD personnel. A work plan was greed upon and consisted of the following. A 1-3' excavation of the affected area was performed according to the ability of the rock type soils to be removed. The excavated materials were removed and hauled to an approved disposal facility. The area was backfilled with clean like soils and the spill was closed.
