Burlington Resources Oil & Gas, LP ("Burlington") is hereby authorized to surface commingle **oil production** from the following Pools:

Basin Fruitland Coal (71629)  
Basin Dakota (71599)

and from the following two diversely owned wells located on Federal leases in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico:

San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 211F (API 30-039-30048) Unit L of Sec. 8, T28N, R6W, NMPM  
Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 414 (API 30-039-24961) Unit L of Sec 8, T28N, R6W, NMPM  
Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The oil sales point for the commingled production shall be located in Unit L of Section 8, Township 28 North, Range 6 West. Oil production from the wells is approved for off lease measurement and sales. Oil production shall be allocated back to the wells on the basis of well tests and the Subtraction Method.


It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
