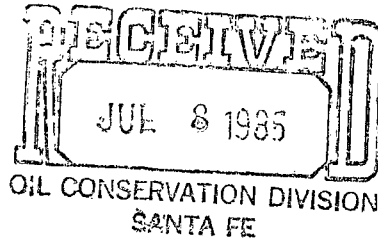

Gentlemen:

We are in the process of filing Forms 9331-C and C-102 with the Bureau of Land Management for permission to drill our newly proposed Wells Federal No. 20 as a Jalmat (Gas) well at a standard Jalmat (Gas) location consisting of 1650' FNL and 660' FWL (E) Section 9, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

We hereby request administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate our newly proposed Wells Federal No. 20 along with the previously existing Wells Federal No. 11 (N-4-25S-37E) to the existing non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit consisting of SE/4 SW/4 Section 4 and NW/4 Section 9, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico (R-1317).

Furthermore, if the proposed well is completed as a commercial producer and in compliance with the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978, an application will be submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to obtain administrative approval for the well as a Section 103 infill well.

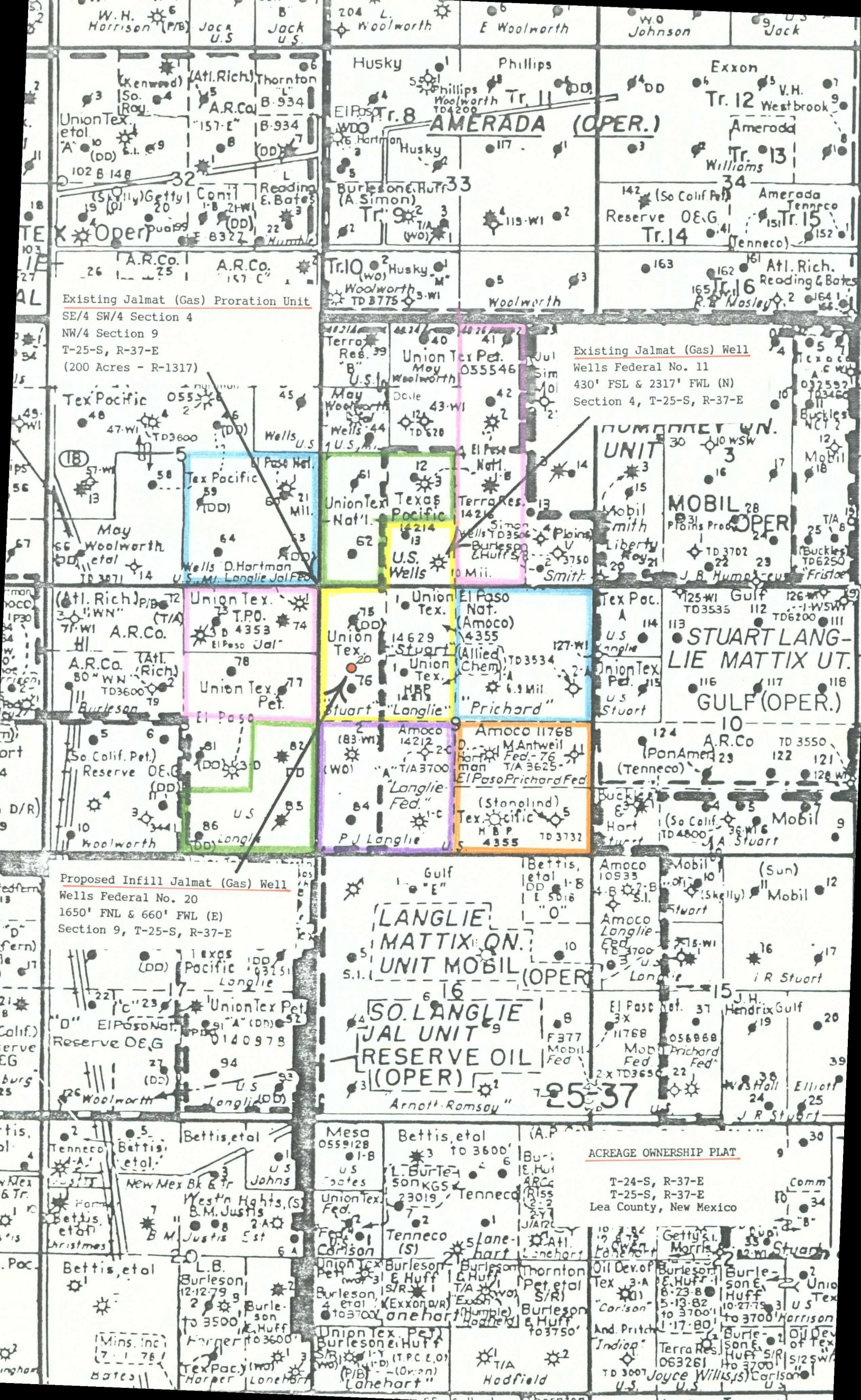
