(2) That the applicant, Texaco Inc., seeks approval of two 160-acre non-standard gas proration units comprising the S/2 NE/4 and N/2 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMMPM, to be dedicated to its C. H. Weir "A" Well No. 12 at an unorthodox location 2307 feet from the North line and 2307 feet from the East line of said Section 12, and the S/2 NW/4 and N/2 SW/4 of Section 12 to be dedicated to its C. share of the gas in the Skaggs-Abo Gas Pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.




