Dear Mr. Renfro:

Per your letter dated April 2, 1991, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Jalmat Gas Pool production to the previously approved non-standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the S/2 of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (Division Administrative Order NSP-1544, dated September 27, 1988), from the existing H.S. Record "WN" Well No. 1 located at a standard gas well location 990 feet from the South and East lines (Unit P) of said Section 10 and to your H.S. Record "WN" Well No. 6 located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South line and 2055 feet from the East line (Unit J) of said Section 10. It is my understanding that the No. 6 well is currently completed in the South Eunice Seven Rivers Queen Pool as a producing oil well and will be properly plugged back and recompleted up-hole into the Jalmat Gas Pool upon issuance of this order.

Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned said 320-acre unit from both wells in any proportion.
