Dear Ms. Malik:

Per your application dated June 19, 1991, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas Pool production to the previously approved non-standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (Division Administrative Order NSP-357, dated March 10, 1957), from the existing

Brownlee Well No. 1 located at a standard gas location 760 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit O) of said Section 25 and to the proposed

Brownlee Well No. 2 to be drilled at a standard gas location 1980 feet from the South line and 810 feet from the East line (Unit I) of said Section 25.

Further, you are permitted to produce the allowable assigned said 160-acre unit from both wells in any proportion.
