This is in reply to your letter dated November 21, 1991, regarding the discrepancy on the captioned Administrative Order and the actual completion of this well.

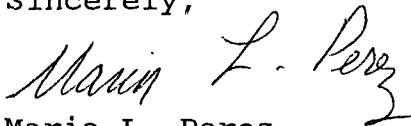

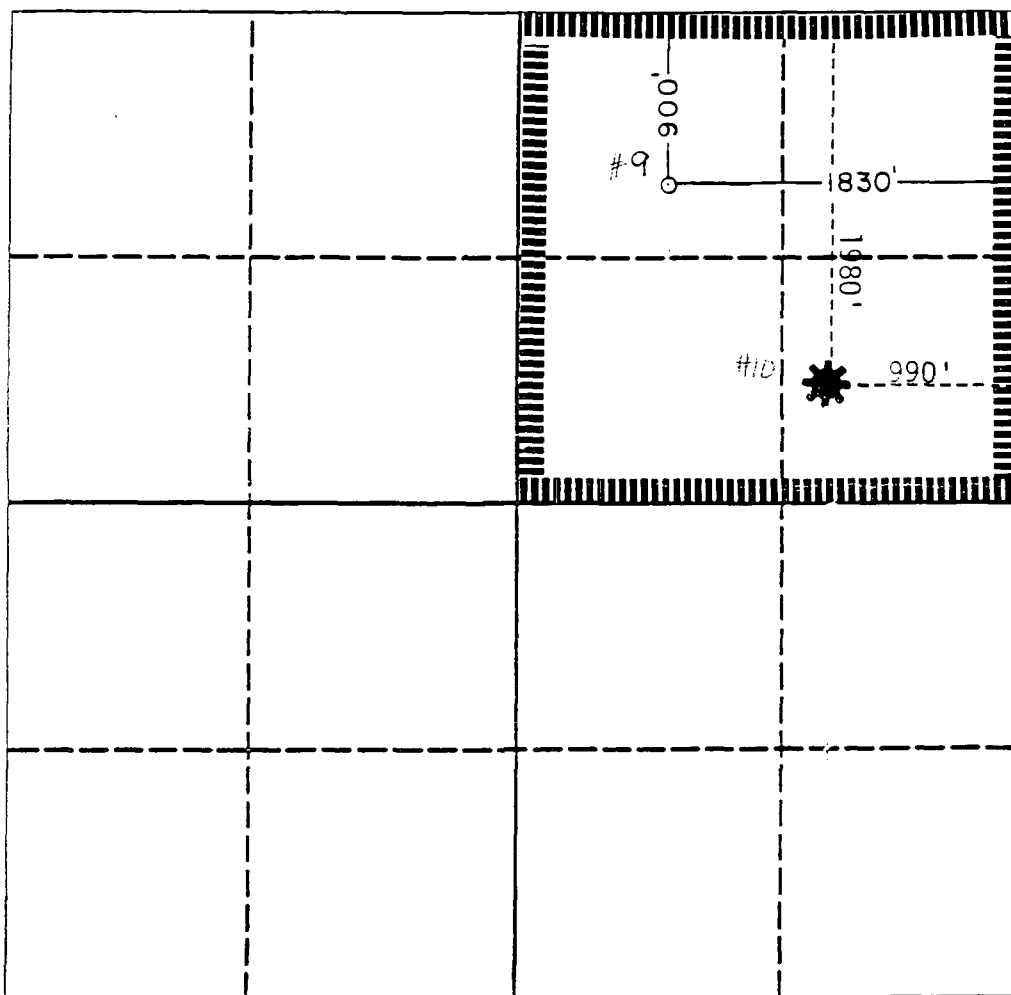

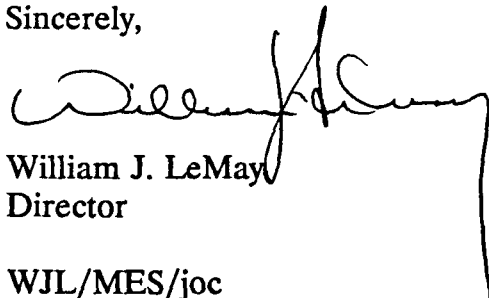

We are currently in the process of filing a C-101 and C-102 with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's district office in Hobbs for permission to drill a second Eumont (Gas) well as an infield well to the same producing interval on an existing 160-acre proration unit comprised of the NE/4 Section 36, T20S, R36E, Unit H, Lea County, New Mexico. The subject proration unit is currently dedicated to our Shell State #10 located in Section 20, T36E, R36E, Unit H. I hereby file for administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the 160-acre proration unit, consisting of the NE/4 Section 36 to both our existing well (Shell State #10) located in Sec. 20S, 36E, R36E, Unit H) and our newly proposed well (Shell State #9) located in Sec. 20S, R36E, R36E, Unit B).

Three copies of a plat showing the location of the original well on the existing 160-acre proration unit plus the location of the proposed well are enclosed.

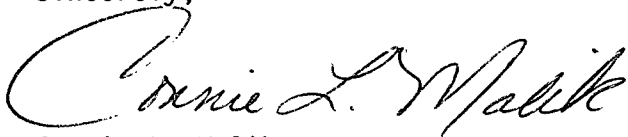
