Contract water hauler left water valve handle on load line and did not close valve at tank; cow rubbed valve open; releasing 45 barrels of produced water; all fluid remained on location. Remedial action included all standing fluids, approximately 35 barrels, were vacuumed-up; backhoe picked-up impacted soil, down to caliche, and properly disposed of impacted soil.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
All fluids remained on location; Length: 140' Width: 4'8' Depth: 2'  
Remedial action included all standing fluids, approximately 35 barrels, were vacuumed-up; backhoe picked-up impacted soil, down to caliche, and properly disposed of impacted soil. Confirmation sampling of soil to occur 6/23/2010; to be witnessed by Bureau of Land Management representative.


