APPLICATION

Comes now applicant, Francis L. Harvey, and hereby applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit as an exception to the pool rules of the Aztec Pictured Cliffs gas pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, said rules being Order No. R-565, Rule 6 (a), this application being brought under the provisions of Rule 6 (b) of said order, as revised, proposed unit to consist of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., as reflected by the plat attached hereto, marked Exhibit a, and made a part hereof, the proposed unit containing 153.20 acres, more or less.

In support of the application, applicant would show:

1. That applicant is present owner of all operating rights in the proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

2. That the well producing from the proposed unit, being applicant's Jones No. 2-F well, is located 1850 feet from the North line of Section 7, and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 7, and was located and drilled in conformance with the rules and regulations then in effect, and was completed as a commercial well productive of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation.

3. That the proposed non-standard proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections, or lots.

4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within Section 7, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

5. That a non-standard gas proration unit allowing less than 160 acres as required by the provisions of Order No. R-565 is necessitated solely by a variation in the governmental survey of said Section 7, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., and unless allowed by the Commission, applicant will be deprived of his opportunity to recover his fair and equitable share of the gas in said pool, contrary to law.

6. That in the opinion of the applicant the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

7. That applicant has on April 15th, 1955, notified operators owning interests in Section 7, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and offset operators to the applicant's Jones No. 2-F well, of applicant's intent to form such non-standard gas proration unit and requesting waivers therefor by sending copies of this application via registered mail to the following:

8. That copies of plat reflecting well location and acreage dedicated to said well are attached hereto as a part of this application.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests he be granted an order by administrative action of the Commission approving a non-standatd gas proration unit as applied for, or in the alternative, that this matter be set for hearing before the Commission in accordance with its rules and regulations, and for such other and further relief as may be proper.




Dear Mr. Kellahin:
